Vamanrao Lokhande is taken as filed and there is no offence

registered against the applicants.

3. It is settled principal of law that FIR is not pre-condition

for preferring anticipatory bail. However, in the instant case, the

police after making inquiry into the application filed by Vamanrao

Lokhande, has not registered FIR against the applicants. Thus, it can

be gathered that there is no reasonable apprehension of arrest at the

hands of police in connection with application filed by Vamanrao

Lokhande. Other than this, the bail application is not supported by

any affidavit. Blanket relief in form of anticipatory bail cannot be

granted. Hence, following order is passed:

ORDER

The application stands rejected.
