- 1. This is an application under section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in Crime No.528/2021 registered at Police Station, Dindori for the offence under sections 498-A, 323, 504 & 506 r/w Sec. 34 of the Indian Penal Code. It is the case of prosecution in brief that the applicants/accused (husband and inlaws of the complainant) inflicted physical and mental cruelty on her.
- 2. Ld. Adv. for the applicants has submitted that a false complaint has been filed against the applicants. They have complied with the terms and conditions imposed by the Court while granting interim relief.
- 3. Per contra, Ld. A.P.P. has opposed the application on the ground that custodial interrogation of the applicants is necessary.
- 4. Applicants have complied with the terms and conditions imposed by the Court and co-operated with the investigating agency.

Offence is primarily under section 498-A of the I.P.C. Therefore, in view of the guidelines laid down by the Apex Court in the case of **Arnesh Kumar Vs. State of Bihar, (2014) 8 SCC 273,** I am inclined to allow the application subject to the following terms and conditions.

ORDER

- 1) Application is allowed.
- 2) Interim order dated 25/01/2022 passed below Exh.4 is hereby confirmed on the same terms and conditions.
